A New World Begins

The World becomes new and that's a reality in front of us. The molting of this new world has several reasons; End the breathless of nuclear negotiations with whatever the results future will bring, marks a different world since noon yesterday. Without overstatement few events had been in history that changed process of the world. Iran nuclear negotiation with six of world powers is one of the same events. From today the hefty international history book seven dimensional dialogues will begin which obtain the end of a long dispute and it is a silver lining window which open in front of who concerned of future world. Whether Iran has been won or west in diplomatic duel is not important for history. The re-emphasize on understanding of the "diplomacy power" is the important issue that to recognize the only real established window of peace and potent order world.

"Table of negotiation" becomes a sign in the "modern new world". Today's international community resolves great challenges between super powers or the conflict in the interest of these powers with regional or trans-regional ones with negotiation and talks. In this new era no one cheer for anthem of war. It might not end the opposition, as the hostility between Iran and America is fixed but even with the hostility we can seat behind the negotiation table. We can consider the national interests and values but we can convince the enemy with the negotiation. The first evidence of this example is in the Zarif and Kerry's smile. Where they were agent of their countries national interests instead of threaten each other they shake hands with the friendly posture in front of flashes of cameras. They seat behind the diplomacy table and find the respectful resolution for their issues. In the new era table of negotiation changes the concept of hostility. However the dignity and identity of Iran and America's dissatisfaction with each other still exist but now at least this hostility and conflict is a silenced issue; nuclear dispute is the issue that in the past never suspected to reach agreement with negotiation. Nuclear agreement has a mark for the world that two governments with their conflicted world aim on their interests can reach a single formula for their interests and benefits and therefore put gun down. It is evidence for which maybe Iran doesn't become allied with west and maybe west for stopping Iran's influence on the region makes no hesitant but hostility can be balanced with "diplomatic powers" and wear the suspension dress. Today Iran is a weighty reliable country which can stand next to other countries and give credible to the world. America and its allied countries never speak about changing Iran's government. Though they have their typical aim but they will say they reach agreement with Iran and from now on they never have the courage to utter their malicious aim. As negotiation reveal the signs of new era, it also rewrites the international communication philosophy; it established a complicated process in which might separate the friends and gather together the enemies. Joint statement by Iranian Foreign Minister Javad Zarif and EU High Representative Federica Mogherini

Today is an historic day. It is a great honour for us to announce that we have reached an agreement on the Iranian nuclear issue. With courage, political will, mutual respect and leadership, we delivered on what the world was hoping for: a shared commitment to peace and to join hands in order to make our world safer. This is an historic day also because we are creating the conditions for building trust and opening a new chapter in our relationship. This achievement is the result of a collective effort. No one ever thought it would be easy. Historic decisions never are. But despite all twists and turns of the talks, and the number of extensions, hope and determination enabled us to overcome all the difficult moments. We have always been aware we had a responsibility to our generation and the future ones. Thanks to the constructive engagement of all parties, and the dedication and ability of our teams,

we have successfully concluded negotiations and resolved a dispute that lasted more than 10 years. Many people brought these difficult negotiations forward during the last decade and we would like to thank all of them - as we would like to thank the International Atomic Energy Agency for its critical contribution and close cooperation as well as the Austrian government for the support and hospitality. We, the EU High Representative for Foreign and Security policy and the Foreign Minister of the Islamic Republic of Iran, together with the Foreign Ministers of the People's Republic of China, France, Germany, the Russian Federation, the United Kingdom and the United States of America met here in Vienna, following several months of intensive work, at various levels and in different formats, to negotiate the text of the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA), based on the key parameters agreed in Lausanne on 2 April.

We have today agreed on the final text of this Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action. The E3/EU+3 (Group 5+1) and the Islamic Republic of Iran welcome this historic Joint Comprehensive Plan

of Action (JCPOA), which will ensure that Iran's nuclear programme will be exclusively peaceful, and mark a fundamental shift in their approach to this issue. They anticipate that full implementation of this Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action will positively contribute to regional and international peace and security. Iran reaffirms that under no circumstances will Iran ever seek, develop or acquire any nuclear weapons.

The Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action includes Iran's own long-term plan with agreed limitations on Iran's nuclear program, and will produce the comprehensive lifting of all UN Security Council sanctions as well as multilateral and national sanctions related to Iran's nuclear programme, including steps on access in areas of trade, technology, finance, and energy.

The Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action comprises of a main text, and five technical annexes - on nuclear, sanctions, civil nuclear energy cooperation, a joint commission, and implementation. These documents are detailed and specific: that is important because all sides wanted clarity so as to ensure the full and

effective implementation of the agreement.

The Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action is a balanced deal that respects the interests of all sides. It is also complex, detailed and technical: we cannot fully summarise the agreement now. But the full main text and all its annexes will be made public still today and will be presented within the next few days by the E3+3 (Group 5+1) to the Security Council for endorsement.

We know that this agreement will be subject to intense scrutiny. But what we are announcing today is not only a deal but a good deal. And a good deal for all sides - and the wider international community.

This agreement opens new possibilities and a way forward to end a crisis that has lasted for more than 10 years. We are committed to make sure this Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action is fully implemented, counting also on the contribution of the International Atomic Energy Agency. We call on the world community to support the implementation of this historic effort. This is the conclusion of our negotiations, but this is not the end of our common work. We will keep doing this important task together.
